

Workshop 2011-03-08

Placemat Activity

How to process:

After formation of the three groups every group has to do the following:

Mark out one member of your group for being the time manager, one for being the writer for the placemat and the poster and one for being the presenter.

1. Think (thinking about and writing):
Each group of students does a brainstorming and notices its ideas concerning the topic in its part of the placemat (please notice your ideas in the field with the number of your group)
After given time all groups change their places (1 \Rightarrow 2, 2 \Rightarrow 3, 3 \Rightarrow 1)
2. Pair (silent comparison):
Each group reads the notices of the former group and does its own brainstorming. All minds are filled in the part of the placemat with the number of the group.
After given time all groups change their places (1 \Rightarrow 3, 2 \Rightarrow 1, 3 \Rightarrow 2)
3. Share (sharing and agreement):
Each group returns to its own placemat.
Afterwards all members of each group decide together which minds are the most important ones and write them down in the middle part of the placemat (not more than 6 points).
4. Then each group creates its own poster on a flip chart paper and presents its selected points to the whole workshop group.
