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Evaluation in Austria

- In Austria doesn't exist a general system of evaluation.
- Each teacher is allowed to create his/her own evaluation system in the context of law.

On the next slides we present you our own evaluation system.



EVALUATION



1st day of the school year:

- Trainees get an information sheet
- Explanation how the information sheet will work
 - **3 parts:** 1. + 2. test + active participation
 - Separate points for every part
 - **2 Tests:** consist of different exercises
(e. g. questions of the last lessons, vocabularies of the last lessons, business letter, listening comprehension)
 - **Active participation:** vocabulary, presentation, oral skills

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Part marks of the 3 parts
(1. + 2. Test + active participation)

Each part results in a part mark at the end of the school year.

100 – 92 points	1 = Sehr gut	Very good
91 – 80 points	2 = Gut	Good
79 – 65 points	3 = Befriedigend	Satisfactory
64 – 50 points	4 = Genügend	Sufficient
less than 50 points	5 = Nicht genügend	Fail



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Overall mark



The sum of the 3 part marks divided by 3 results in the overall mark

Commercial roundings of the marks

e. g. $2,4 = \text{overall mark } 2$

$2,5 = \text{overall mark } 3$

Overall mark can be influenced by:

- Performance rising or falling
- Positive way of behaving
- Punctualness
- Reliability
