Vocational School in Austria = Dual System

✤ The education lasts 2 – 4 years, depending on kind of trade

double-apprenticeship (4 y.) = possible in related professions
 e. g. baker + sugar baker, cook + waiter



The company has to register the apprentice.

40 weeks with 1 schoolday / week + 10 weeks 1 additional day in any term	10 weeks nonstop with 5 schooldays / week in any term

Some facts:

- Apprentices may only be trained in the legally recognized apprenticeship trades (presently approximately 240).
- At present there are about 132.000 apprentices in about 40.000 companies.
- The most popular professions are retail dealer for girls and automobile mechanics for boys.
- Upon completion of apprenticeship training about 40 % of all apprentices continue to work for the company where they were trained.

Students at Vocational Schools (Dual System)

Tuition fees paid by municipality

 € 200,00 (+ € 200,00 support for investment in equipment)

 Books: ~ € 100,00 = → students pay ~ € 5,50 / year


Accomodation during the term:


- mostly boarding schools
- payment: € 100,00 € 125,00 /week (incl. food)
- often financial support by employer *)

Apprenticeship:

→ wages from € 250,00 – € 1.100,00 b.t. 14 x per year *)

*) cf. regulations in collective contracts

min. 3 years job experience

 qualifies for starting up own business

Access to University – requirements:

- higher education entrance
 examination
 - 3 subjects: German,
 Mathematics, English
 - 1 subject: related to field of work experience and intended study

Teaching subjects in Vocational Schools (Dual System)

Subject group 1	 commercial subjects, German, English, Political Education
Subject group 2	 profession-related theoretical subjects (e.g. logistics, advertisement, knowledge in food sector, aso)
Subject group 3	 profession-related practical subjects (e.g. teaching practical work in kitchens, workshops, aso)

Qualifications to become a Vocational Teacher (Dual System)

Teachers of Subject-Group 1 + 2

- graduation from Vocational (technical, commercial, etc.)
 College (matriculation) or higher level
- min. 3 years work-experience in this field


Teachers of Subject-Group 3

- graduation from Vocational School (Dual System)
- examination for the master's certificate
- higher education entrance examination
- min. 3 years work-experience in this field

Vocational Teacher Education

Modular system

- each module contains various subjects / fields of study, e.g.
 Basics of Human Sciences
- each module is finished by exams (oral or written)
- with each module students earn ECTS-points, e. g. Basics of Human Sciences = 6 ECTS/semester (average = 2,25 schoolhours/week)
- Some modules are credited due to former work-experience

The fields of study are split into various lectures, seminars, exercises, e.g.

- Pedagogical Sociology
- Pedagogical Psychology
- Educational Sciences
- Didactics
- Practical Teaching Exercises
- Language (German or English)
- Business Administration
- School Laws
- Political Education
- Accountancy (only teachers of subject group 1)
- Special knowledge in job-related subjects (group 2 + 3)

Vocational Education System in Austria Vocational Teacher: Salary

Dual System

for full-time occupation = 23 lessons à 50 min per week

1 st – 5 th year:	€ 2.425,00 before taxes / month (14 x per year)
6 th – 10 th year:	€ 2.864,30 b. t.
from 11 th year:	€ 3.572,10 b. t.

Remunerations for various duties (per school-month)	
Head teacher of a class	€ 133,20
Custodian (e. g. library)	€ 48,80
Workshop (e.g. for carpenters)	€ 92,60

Advantages and Disadvantages of the Austrian system of education

Advantages

- Finish of the study within 3-5 years
- Course is fixed (disadvantage?)
- Earn basic salary as fulltime students
- Practice-knowledge is a profit for the trainees

Disadvantages

- The start without pedagogical knowledge is very hard
- Amount of work (4 working days
 + 1 study day)
- No options in the study (curriculum is fixed)

Some facts:

There are 26 Vocational Schools with about 1.200 vocational teachers in Upper Austria.

The average age of vocational teachers starting their job is 36 years!

Curriculum of Vocational Schools


Special Needs Education

prolongation of apprenticeship, e.g

retailer: regular time 3 years \rightarrow 4 years for slower learners

partial qualification

- set-up of individual curriculum
- integration into worklife for students who aren't able to pass full education



Differences / Impressions: Vocational Teacher Education

- more attendance at University
- is based on a modular system
- special academic teacher education
- pedagogical studies
- complementary studies



study for 3 years including 1 year fulltime study



- → academic degree is needed before starting education
- less attendance at University
- more self-guided studies
- various further lectures (e. g. Contact days)
- only pedagogical studies
- Istudy for 1 − 1,5 years
- system of "Guidance and Councelling"



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
